- Should an issue arise that I am not comfortable with, I will address my concern(s) to the following individuals in this order 1) Head Coach 2) Football or Cheerleading Director 3) President or Vice President.

- I understand that immediate removal from the MMYFCA may result if I do not abide by the Parent Code of Ethics.
